*Officiant and People:* **Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit: as it was in the beginning, is now, and will be for ever. Amen.**

**A Litany for Peace**

**Leader:** Be present to all your children ravaged by violence. Be present to those who use violence and those harmed by it. Safeguard our brothers and sisters in law enforcement who step into the violence to bring peace. Shelter us all in the warmth of your love and bring peace to your people; **People: Deliver us from evil.**

**Leader:** Work within our world, and within each of us, to nurture tenderness, forgiveness, caring and peace. Use us as agents of change, lights of your love, and channels of your peace. **People: For yours is the kingdom, the power and the glory, forever and ever. Amen.**
